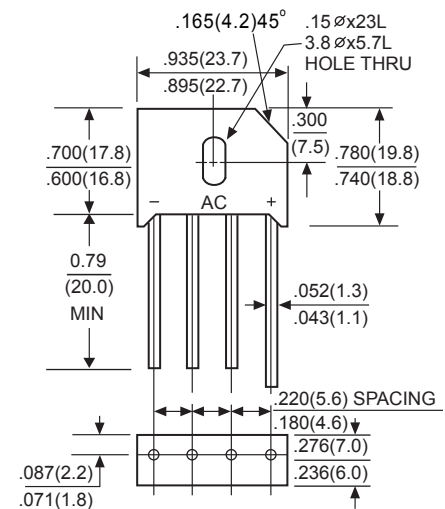

DERATING CURVE

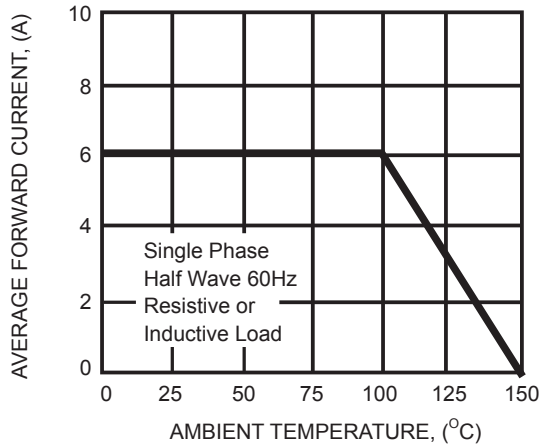

SURGE CURRENT

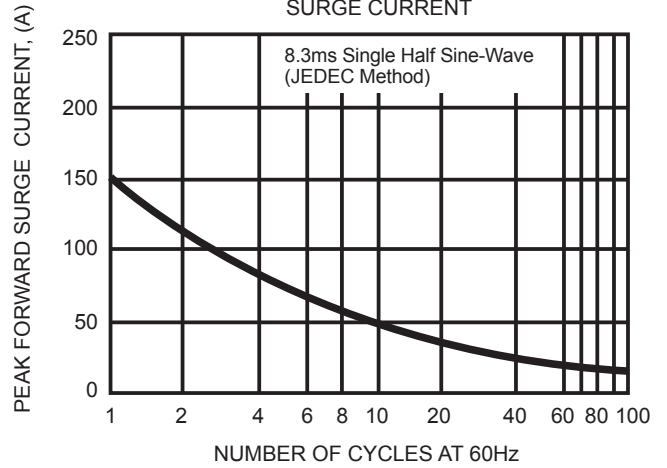

FORWARD CHARACTERISTICS

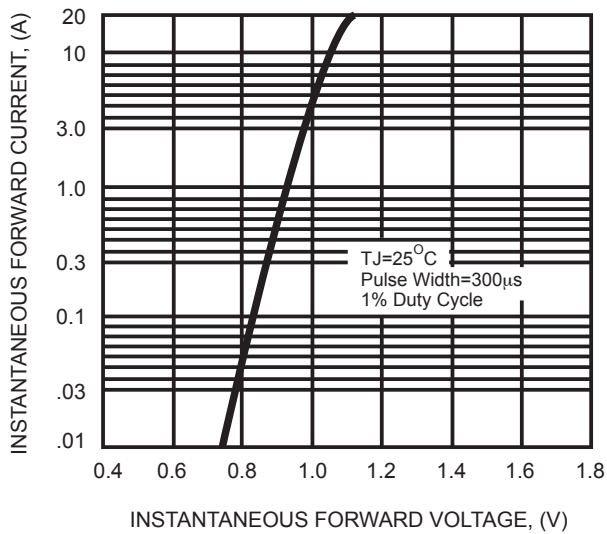

TYPICAL REVERSE CHARACTERISTICS

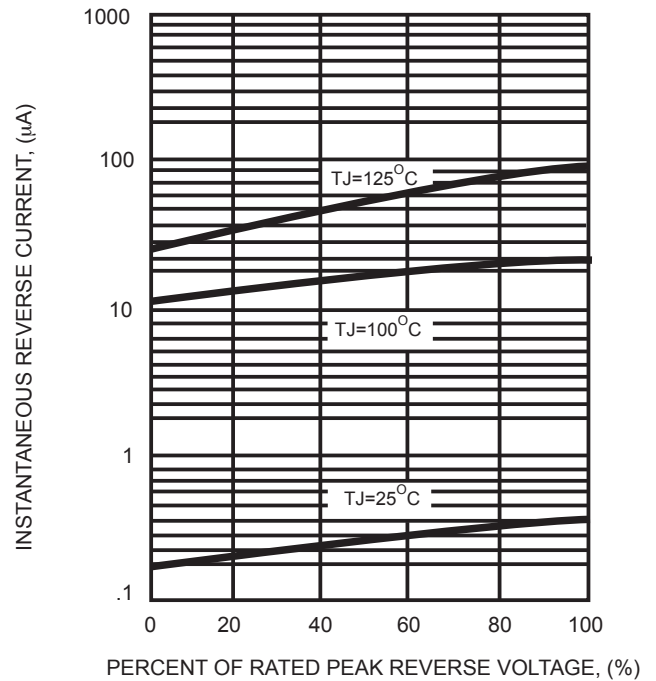
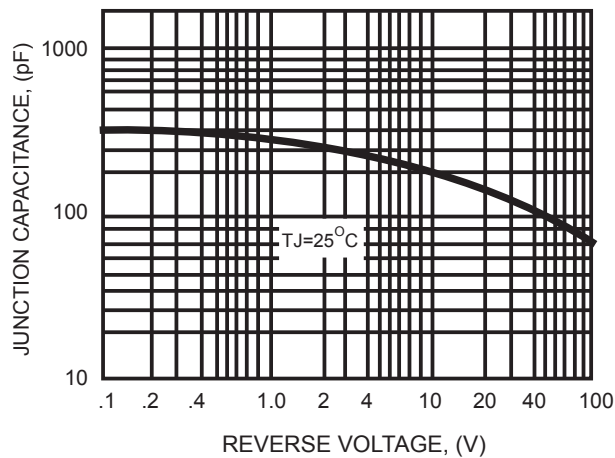
